<b>ARC Scholarship</b>	Recognizes a young woman in a STEM field of study.
<b>Bay Area Kiwanis Scholarship</b>	Recognizes an active and exemplary graduate
<b>Bay Area Sportsman's Assn</b>	Preference to NBHS senior planning to major in forestry, fish and wildlife management, marine biology, or natural sciences
<b>Don and Bernice Borglum Fund</b>	Slight preference to health-related career, with demonstrated financial need
<b>Conner Family Scholarship</b>	Preference to junior, senior or advance study of Pharmacy at OSU
<b>Dick Doyle Honorarium</b>	Limited to post BA/BS study in school administration or counseling
<b>Flaxel Family Scholarship</b>	Recognizes a dedicated NBHS graduating athlete who has maintained adequate grades and demonstrated good sportsmanship. No requirement of planned college athletics
<b>Gould Family Scholarship</b>	Preference to trades or technological emphasis
<b>John and Mary Hanson Memorial</b>	Restricted to student planning to or attending private college/university, excellent academics required, no limitation on field of study
<b>Eric Benford Henson Memorial</b>	For study of language or fine arts, student with history of service to others, preference to University of Oregon
<b>Paul Hillar / W.M. Hillar Estate</b>	For major in 2 or 4 year degree program in health education or related field
<b>Sven &amp; Peggy Janson Estate</b>	Broad selection with emphasis on well defined career goals.
<b>Heidi Johnson Memorial</b>	Study at Oregon college/university with preference to Lane C.C., with no restriction on degree field
<b>Joycolynn &amp; Walter Joslin Estate</b>	No limit on school or choice of field of study, academics given some consideration, several awards of \$3,000 each with at least one to a graduating NBHS senior
<b>Esther LaClair-Probst Memorial</b>	Preference given to study in vocational fields
<b>Eugene LaClair Memorial</b>	Preference given to study in mathematics and/or science field
<b>Max &amp; Jean McNamar Memorial</b>	No limit on school or field of study
<b>Longley F. McSwain Scholarship</b>	Preference given to the study of Architecture
<b>Murto Family Fund</b>	Enrolled at SWOCC
<b>Beverly Slaney Nelson Estate</b>	Preference given to study of fine arts, especially visual arts
<b>North Bend Student Loan Fund</b>	Open to all fields of study, academic, technical or vocational
<b>Forrest &amp; Pauline Perry Estate</b>	Financial need considered for a student with well-defined career goal. Technology/vocational programs equal importance to college/university
<b>Linda M. Pfaender Memorial Nursing Scholarship</b>	Must be already in nursing program or post degree such as administration, supervising, research etc.
<b>Jerry &amp; LaRose Phillips Memorial</b>	Environmental issues with emphasis on forestry, or elementary education, preference at SWOCC or OSU
<b>Pittam Family Trust</b>	Preference to NBHS senior planning to major in elementary education

<b>Brian Prentice Estate</b>	Slight preference to computer science
<b>Jason Poppe Memorial</b>	Graduating senior, high academics & personal standards, athletic participant, to major in science, math, engineering or related field, preference to OSU
<b>Fred William Probst Estate Probst Family Trust</b>	Broad selection with emphasis on academic achievement and clear goal Open to all fields of study, academic, technical or vocational, awards of \$3,000
<b>Olive Beaudry Probst Memorial</b>	Limited to SWOCC
<b>Mark Sandberg Music Memorial</b>	For NBHS senior to study music at Oregon college/university, preference to University of Oregon
<b>Schepman/Gebhardt Fund</b>	Broad selection with emphasis on well defined career goals
<b>Frank Shriver Memorial</b>	Recognizes student planning to attend or currently enrolled at an Oregon college/university to major in secondary teaching, coaching, or counseling
<b>Hilda "Johnnie" Shriver Memorial</b>	Preference to student currently admitted/enrolled in professional nursing or related program at an Oregon community college or university
<b>Dr. Keith Shriver Memorial</b>	Current graduate, student athlete, business/teaching or accounting
<b>Vivian Shriver Thompson Estate</b>	Recognizes college junior or senior at an Oregon school (preference to OSU) enrolled in wide variety of environmental study areas
<b>Vivian Shriver Thompson Estate</b>	Preference to Oregon State University junior or senior in College of Home Economics and Education, majoring in nutrition or dietetics
<b>Virginia Lou Slaney</b>	Open to all fields of study, academic, technical or vocational
<b>The Ian Spalding Dedication to Excellence Scholarship</b>	Recognizes a multi-sport student athlete with high grades, leadership, integrity and volunteer service to the community or charities.
<b>Stinchfield Family Fund</b>	Preference to health-related career choice, including mental health
<b>Ken and Joy Ware Scholarship</b>	Open to all fields of study, financial need is important, but not limiting
<b>Jerrold K. Wyatt Family Trust</b>	Preference to SWOCC, forestry/natural resources, family with ILWU affiliation
<b>Aimee Why Memorial</b>	Preference to junior or senior in Oregon state-supported college/university majoring in pre-dentistry, dental hygiene, or science

<b>Brian Chaney Family Scholarship</b>	Preference given to study of Forestry and/or Education
<b>Coolen Family Scholarship</b>	Limited to undergraduate study at George Fox University ( <i>excludes online</i> )
<b>Mid Columbia Bus</b>	Broad selection, awards to current graduate
<b>Murto 'Trade' Scholarship</b>	Pursuing a trade, enrolled at Swocc
<b>Gene Pierce Memorial</b>	For study of public safety, with preference to law enforcement
<b>Jim Scavera Scholarship</b>	Award to current graduate enrolling at Swocc
<b>Philip A. Scheideman Memorial</b>	Criteria: selection committee discretion
<b>F. Willis Smith Fund</b>	Endowed through the Oregon Community Foundation to make yearly contributions of interest earned. No specific criteria established beyond general NBBSF eligibility
<b>The Ian Spalding Award</b>	Recognizes a multi-sport student athlete with high grades, leadership, and integrity
<b>Trumbull-Chaney Bulldog Family Award</b>	Current graduating senior, at least one parent/guardian must be NBBS graduate, field of study not specified
